


The Entrance Bucket List

Start the day with a local café. Kick start with caffeine or brekky from a café along The Entrance high street or waterfront.
Ride a 19th Century carousel. The Entrance Historic Carousel has proudly sat on the water's edge of The Entrance since the 1930s. Originating from Germany in the 1800s, the carousel is now recognised by the National Trust as one of the oldest carousels in Australia.
Casual lunch or indulge at dinner. Whether it's a high tea in a heritage building, gourmet pies by the sea or fine dining with an amazing view, The Entrance is packed full of dining venues to choose from.
Outdoor sport at Picnic Point Reserve. Right at the tip of The Entrance sits a lovely green space known as Picnic Point Reserve, featuring a skate park, boat ramp, fishing spot and playground, linked by a shared pathway along the foreshore.
Stop to take a dip in the historic Grant McBride Ocean Baths. Experience swimming in fresh ocean water pools, some child-friendly and shallow and some with lap sections.
Fishing and prawning in the channel. Organise a fishing licence from The Entrance Visitor Centre and try your hand at fishing by the bridge. In season, grab your waders and torch to try your hand at catching some fresh Tuggerah Lakes prawns in the channel at night - don't forget to ask the locals for advice.
Pelican Time. Enjoy an eco-friendly educational experience that give locals and visitors a unique insight into the region's special Pelicans.
Take the Coast to Lake Walk. The best way to explore the area on foot is this signposted scenic trail from lakeside Long Jetty to seaside Toowoon Bay.
Splash around in Vera's Water Garden. Adjacent to the historic carousel in Memorial Park, is this colourful water-based play space for children during the warmer months.
Get the local info. Stop into the Central Coast Visitor Centre where you will find maps, accommodation choices, dining options and locally made merchandise. Don't forget to ask for a copy of the scavenger hunt too!
Hire a boat from The Entrance Boat Shed. A slice of history, originally built in the 1920s. The Boat Shed hires out motorboats, kayaks, SUPs, canoes and fishing equipment to make the most of Tuggerah Lake.
Marvel at hundreds of retro cars. Chromefest is an annual event on the Coast every October; a tribute to classic American autos, hot rods, rock n' roll and rockabilly.
Venture north. There is another side to this town – cross the bridge to discover The Entrance North.
